Hello Highland!

I still like paper maps. I know that makes me an old soul, but there is something about a paper map that I lose when I use my phone. When I pull out my phone and type in an address I immediately receive three route options to my destination along with current traffic, an estimated time of arrival, the exact distance to my location and the weather along the way. The information overload is amazing and I love it, but the price of this convenience and immediate gratification is my own engagement. I do not have to think. My phone has done all the thinking for me so that I can disengage. All I have to do is turn off my brain, disengage, and follow the step by step instructions from the calm, yet firm, British voice coming from my phone telling me "in three hundred feet, turn left".

When I open a paper map the opposite is true, I must engage my brain. I have to look up and get a sense of where I am or I will never figure out how to get where I want to go. I have to pay attention to each road crossing and intersection because no one is telling me to "take the next left". I have to pay attention to how I unfolded the map or I may never get it back into its compact state again. I can't just go through the motions, I must be fully engaged, and my engagement causes me to gain a level of understanding about my trip that mindlessly following my phone could never achieve.

This is the idea the psalmist explains in Psalm 119:130 when he writes, "The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple." The time and effort it takes to unfold the Word of God can not be substituted by the conveniences of modernity. Sometimes the process of finding the answer is more rewarding than the answer itself. Unfolding the Word of God, engaging with it and seeking to understand it is just like using a paper map. Sure, we could google the answer, but the process of our own search causes a deeper appreciation of His Word. Let us be a people who seek to understand our God by unfolding our copies of His Word before we see what someone else has said


